### **We the People of Brown County (WTP-BC)**

#### ***Who are we?***

We are a group of concerned Christian conservatives living in Brown County that see an excessive overreach of government power from all levels stealing our constitutional rights, civil rights, medical rights and human rights. As free people of the United States of America, we have the right to choose what is best for us, our family, and our communities.

Under the premise of a pandemic, our federal government deceived and misled the people of the United States to believe that the Covid virus was a threat to the health of our nation. Two years later, we realized that the data shows Covid has the same properties as the seasonal Influenza. Covid mortality rate is low (99.9% Survivable), and doesn't warrant the draconian type of government overreach seen across our nation. "We the People" have a moral obligation to stand against the tyranny of government overreach. Our actions must reign in the government's excessive overreach in order to preserve our future freedoms and liberties.

... God is First...in our families, churches, cities, counties, and in our state and federal government. We are not ashamed of the Gospel of Jesus Christ for it is the power of God unto Salvation.

... In protecting all citizens' rights. We the People have the ultimate authority and obligation to serve and protect all citizens' rights against all enemies, foreign and domestic.

... Life begins at conception. As such, each unborn child is part of God's family, and deserves our protection just like the rest of the people.

... In limited, responsible government. Government has limited power and authority as it is specifically spelled out in the Constitution. Government closest to the people is best and we must trust that our government is going to implement good fiscal policies and responsibilities.

... Power and Authority originates with "We the People". We the People give the Constitution its authority and the Constitution gives the government its authority.

... that all levels of government must operate under truth and transparency.

... In EQUAL rights, not special rights. Our founding documents clearly state that "all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." Any group that promotes itself because of race, ethnicity, sexual orientation or social/economic status is declaring itself as "SPECIAL" and deserving preferential treatment from all. This is divisive and is the very definition of discrimination. These types of groups or organizations must not be catered to.

... In encouraging personal responsibility...spiritual, financial and social responsibility for all people. As in the words from President John F. Kennedy, “Ask not what your country can do for you, but what you can do for your country.”

... In fair taxes. The Constitution makes provision for taxing the people for specific reasons. One of the most egregious taxations on the people is property taxes. This is a tax on assets that have had an increase in value but haven't been realized through the sale of that property. People are getting taxed out of their homes. This tax must be reformed immediately.

... that Constitutional Law is the law of the land, not case law. Establishing and creating laws is the sole responsibility of our Legislatures. Political parties have moved that process from the Legislature to the court systems. Setting precedence seems to be the modus operandi for creating law in the United States. That is not how the Constitution establishes creating laws. We must get back to the Constitution as the law of the land.

1. **God Fearing** – No compromise.
2. **Integrity** – Political talk is cheap. Actions based on personal Biblical World values will drive a person's integrity.
3. **Leadership not Politics** – Politics has gotten us into this predicament. Leadership will get us out of this mess. “When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice. But, when a wicked man rules, the people groan.” Proverbs 29:2 NKJV
4. **Courageous Warriors of Truth** - Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, He is the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you.” Deuteronomy 31:6 NKJV
5. **Servants Heart for the People** – Understanding that their elected position is to serve God first and the people second.
